One Day Classes

1. Controlled Quilting

The fantastic news is anyone can quilt!

All you need is Pauline's Technique of CONTROLLED QUILTING.

Students will learn all about the controlled quilting method and how to easily quilt on their very own domestic sewing machine. Pauline's motto is, "if you can thread the needle on your sewing machine and sew in a straight line, then you can quilt beautifully using our easy Controlled Quilting method!"



This class is designed to show anyone who has tried to quilt using the Free Motion method that there is an easier and very achievable method. All that's needed to be a fantastic quilter is a domestic sewing machine and an open toe foot (not an open Toe Free Motion foot) on the machine.

Students will learn lots of great tips about their sewing machine that will make quilting a dream for all who attend the class.

Be assured this class is so worth it as it is so gratifying. Pauline will show students that there is nothing scary about quilting and that you can be a confident quilter too!



2. QUILT AS YOU GO, SAMPLE TECHNIQUES

Two different techniques will be taught in this class!

**Note: There will be pre workshop preparation that will need to be completed by each student prior to the class.*

There are many easy ways to join your quilts and other smaller projects using Pauline's QAYG techniques.

Pauline (and many others!) find it much more enjoyable to make quilts this way, as you no longer have to struggle with pushing and pulling a large quilt through the small space on a domestic sewing machine to quilt.

Students will be taken through the process of quilting each block before joining the blocks together with a Sashing. They will learn how to quilt the borders for a QAYG quilt first, before joining them to the quilt.

Once they learn the techniques, it will be achievable to quilt their own quilts and will be able to have fun creating many projects using their new skills.



One Day Classes

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3. The Robbie Hat

**Note: There will be pre workshop preparation that will need to be completed by each student prior to the class.*

Join Pauline in this two-part lesson, where she will teach your students how to make fun and funky fabric hats from 1 ½" inch strips of fabric.

Learn how using a HoneyBun Sasher make the process SO much quicker and easier. These hats can truly be customised to suit each student's style and even make one for every member of the family, from a toddler up to an adult size.

This is a fun and enjoyable class to be part of.



4. The Cabarlah Jelly Roll Bag

**Note: There will be pre workshop preparation that will need to be completed by each student prior to the class.*

Join in Pauline's class and learn how to make fantastic bags from a Jelly Roll bundle or by using 2 ½" fabric strips from your stash.

Learn how using a Jelly Roll Sasher makes the process SO much quicker and easier. The bag students will create is very durable so they can take it anywhere they like – create a stylish bag to take shopping or make a tote bag to take to the beach.

Once the techniques have been learnt, it is a very easy project and makes a great gift idea for friends and family.



5. HoneyBun Bowls

What is a HoneyBun? What is a Honeybun Sasher?

Starting from the basics, this class reveals it all.

Pauline will teach students just how relaxing and fun it can be to create HoneyBun Bowls.

This is a fantastic class for students to use up fabric from their stash, since they just need 1 ½" strips of fabric or a prepacked HoneyBun bundle.

Students will be able to create any size bowl, basket or even a bag once they get an understanding on how to manipulate the fabric to create the desired shape as they sew.

This is truly a fun class to participate in.



Two Day Classes

** A two day workshop will be enough time to finish a small project.*

1. Controlled Quilting and Quilt As You Go Techniques

**Note: There will be pre workshop preparation that will need to be completed by each student prior to the class.*

DAY 1:

Together students will focus on using traditional means to achieve creative expression in their quilting journey.

This class is for those who want to master quilting without the stress of Free Motion Quilting. Students will be taught simple but stunning designs with the feed dogs up on their machines. This is a surprisingly easy and relaxing class, with fantastic results for all participating.

DAY 2:

Learn all of Pauline's Quilt as You Go techniques. Students will go home with samples of the different techniques they have learnt, to enable them to use these samples in the future when they make any quilt pattern into a QAYG quilt.



2. Crazy Patch Gone Modern

Crazy Patch has been around for centuries, traditionally it was made from bits and pieces of different textured fabrics and trims.

In this class, students will put a twist on the tradition to create a modern look.

Students will learn how to create perfect Bias trims and once everything is in place, they will quilt the blocks and join them together with Quilt as You Go methods.

The outcome from this class will be amazing.



3. Not So Celtic Cushion

This is an easy, relaxed class to learn about both Controlled Quilting and Bias Celtic designs. The design for this class is simple but very effective and stylish.

Students will be taught how to make perfect bias in the color they choose, as well as how to approach all the bias strips that go under and over each other to create wonderful Celtic designs.

Some fantastic machine techniques are taught in this class that students can apply to other projects.

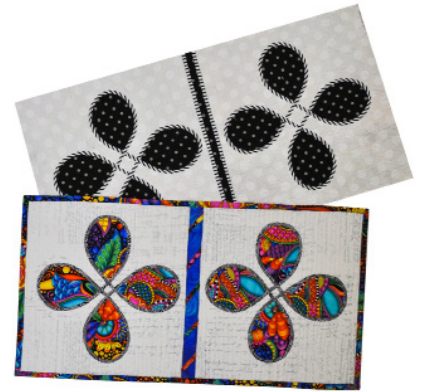

4. Back to Back QAYG Table Runner

Machine quilting is one of those things that can be quite the challenge or a great joy. If you've become discouraged with domestic machine quilting after trying to fit a large quilt through your sewing machine, you should give Quilt As You Go a try.

In this class you will learn Pauline's Back to Back QAYG technique (the easiest of her two techniques) to make a lovely table runner. Discover how quilting one block at a time is remarkably simple.

Once finished, you'll be able to apply the technique to almost any quilt you make, no matter the size.



5. Between the Block QAYG Table Runner

In this class you'll learn the second of Pauline's Quilt As You Go techniques, Between the Block.

The Between the Block QAYG technique needs to be used if any of the blocks in the quilt have a 1/4" point, like on pieced blocks. You'll be taught step-by-step how to make this small table runner, with the technique then able to be applied to any QAYG quilt.



A fantastic class if you never want to struggle with trying to quilt a large quilt on your small domestic sewing machine again.

6. Jelly Roll Rugs

This is a fun and easy class to be part of, where you'll make your own Jelly Roll Rug. Ideal if you have some jelly roll bundles laying around or a lot of fabric in your stash - a great class to use them up and get your creative juices flowing.

Pauline will teach you how to use the PQW Jelly Roll Sasher to make your own jelly roll strips; and how to join them together to form a jelly roll rug.

You will have the choice of what size you'd like to make your rug, with the option to make an oval, bear or butterfly Jelly Roll Rug.



Two Day Classes

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7. Woven Rugs

This is an enjoyable and relaxing class that gives you all the tips and tricks for creating woven rugs.

A great option if you want to use up fabrics from your stash, or purchase new fabrics, to create a unique rug to match your decor. Using the PQW Weaver Sasher Set, Pauline will show you how to create the weaving strips, and the easiest way to weave them under and over to form the base of your rug.

A great class for those who want to do a project where minimal sewing is required. You'll have the option to make either a round, oval, square or rectangle shaped rug.
